Rules of Entry

- Everyone mounted, whether competing or not <u>MUST</u> wear protective Riding Hat conforming to the current British Standard with a British Kite Mark. The Show would advise that all those competing In-hand should wear a Hat to the same standard, see specific Society Rules for requirements if you choose not to wear a Riding Hat whilst showing In-hand, you do so at your own risk.
- No Horse or Pony to be left unattended, tied to Lorry, Horse Box or Trailer.
- No cars to be parked among lorries, horse boxes or trailers.
- ALL HORSE PASSPORTS MUST BE WITH YOU ON SHOW DAY SPOT CHECKS MAY TAKE PLACE.

IN FAIRNESS TO ALL:

- 1. Horse, Rider or Handler may not exhibit in any class where the Judge has in the past, bred, owned, produced or given paid or voluntary instruction to the Horse, Rider or Handler.
- 2. Any Horse or pony found to be over height for a specific class may not take part in that class NO entry fees will be refunded and no substitution of animal or class change will be allowed.
- 3. Any person wishing to report a 'breach of conduct' concerning an exhibitor please report to the Chief Steward or Show Secretary.
- 4. Classes will not be held up for those competing in other rings or classes and no entry fees will be refunded for classes that have been missed. ENTRY FEES:

SHOWING & WORKING HUNTER: Pre-entry £12.00, on the day £15.00 SHOW JUMPING £10.00 CLEAR ROUND £5.00 (ENTRY ON THE DAY ONLY) DOG SHOW £2.00 (ENTRY ON THE DAY ONLY)

FIELD ENTRY FEE: £5 FIRST AID £2.00(PER COMPETITOR)

The organisers and landowners do not accept any liability for accident or damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property.

- The organisers hold the right to amalgamate, alter or cancel any of the classes;
- Verification of horse/pony age and height must be available on request
- It is STRONGLY recommended that all horses and ponies have Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations.
- Handler of any Stallion or Colt must be 14 years old or over. Stallion discs to be worn
- Handlers of ponies in In-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull cap or riding hat which meets current regulations.
- No ill-treatment of ponies or horses at any time, whether by misuse or excessive use of whip, bit, item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.
- A fall of horse, pony or rider in any class will result in disqualification. The rider MUST NOT remount in the ring.
- The rider or handler may not remove their pony or themselves from the ring during judging, without the judge's permission. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
- No unauthorised persons to enter the arenas.
- Riders, handlers and their grooms must, at all times, present themselves in the show ring neatly and smartly dressed.
- The class is closed to competitors once the ring gate is shut. As long as the gate has not been closed a late entry to a class may be accepted, but the competitor must get an official late entry card for the secretary's tent.
- Competitors may enter as many classes as they wish or want. However, if the classes clash the competitor must pick which class takes preference.
- Any Competitor or groom guilty of disobedience or rudeness towards any judge, steward
 or official shall be disqualified and asked to leave the showground. Entry fees will not be
 refunded.
- Side reins, draw reins or grass reins are not permitted when riding on the showground.
- Anyone found galloping around the arenas or on the showground shall be asked to leave immediately.
- Correct hat and boots must be worn when mounted anywhere on the showground
- Complaints or objections must be logged in writing within 30 minutes of completion of the class.
- All dogs on the show fields must be on a short lead and under control
- In the event of a fatality of a horse on the show field, within sight of the public, then the show may be cancelled.
- Please note there will not be a farrier on the field during the show.
- A photographer may be in attendance. Competitors may be photographed and images may be published on social media etc. Any objections to photos being published should be submitted to the Secretary prior to the show.

NPS Scotland/Townhead Pet n Pony In Hand Mountain & Moorland Championship.

Youngstock, stallions, mares and geldings registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book

In Hand M&M Championships: The Champion & Res. Champion in all Mixed, pure-bred M & M, or Breed Championships will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2024.

Qualification may go to 3rd in the Championship (i.e. 1st Reserve Champion)

NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Ridden Mountain and Moorland Championship

Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, BSPS Lemeiux Final or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show and the NPS Scotland/Kilmannan Stud Novice Finals (Blair) (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is de-noviced and cannot compete in the Kilmannan Final at Blair Final.

The **2** highest placed ponies, not already qualified, in each class will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2024. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4**th **place.** This can be either mixed M & M or Breed Classes.

The NPS Scotland / Maggie May Junior Open Ridden Championship (under 14 and under 18)

Mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. **Please note NO Stallions are allowed in the Junior Classes.**

The highest placed Junior Ridden pony, in each Open Ridden Class not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on 23rd August 2024. Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place

NPS Scotland/NFU Mutual Open In-hand Riding Pony/Hunter Pony Championship

The highest placed pony, in each open in-hand Riding Pony or Hunter Pony Class (foal classes excluded) not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2024. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4**th **place**

Hunter Pony. Youngstock, stallions, mares, and geldings not to exceed 153 cms at maturity **Riding Pony**. Youngstock, stallions, mares, and geldings, not to exceed 148 cms at maturity.

NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feed Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship.

Stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book.

The 2 highest placed ponies, not already qualified, will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 23rd August 2024. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4**th place.

NPS Scotland/ Kilgraston School M&M Lead Rein Championship

Mares and geldings four years old and over not exceeding 122 cms, registered in the main body of the following Breed Society stud books:

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A and Welsh B. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

Riders must be at least 3 years old on the day of the class and not to have attained their 9th birthday by the 1st January in the current year.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit with the lead rein attached to the nose band.

Horse & Country Racehorse Membership

The Horse & CountryRacehorses (HCR) series is open to Thoroughbreds and Standardbreds who have raced, trained or been bred to race. Racing injuries will be ignored provided the horse is sound. Riders must be 14 years plus, ridden horses must be 4 years plus and veterans are 12 years plus. Judges will not ride and you will not be asked to gallop as a ride but maybe asked to gallop in your individual show.

HCR members must carry their cards in the ring for signing at qualifying shows and non members must send their qualification cards (presented by the judge), fees and register with HCR after the qualifying show. To qualify you should be placed 1st-4th (qualifications *may* be passed down to 6th place).

All handlers/riders **and** horses must become registered with HCR ahead of the championships and must have qualified in order to complete at the HCR championships at Netherton Equestrian on 7th/8th September 2024. *Our racing ambassadors are Philip Kirby Racing!*

Highland Pony Society Youngstock Championship 2024

- This show is a qualifier from the 2024 Highland Pony Society Youngstock Championship.
- The Champion youngster across classes 28 and 31 will qualify for the Highland Pony Youngstock Championships. If already qualified, the card will pass to the second placed pony but no further.
- Only pure bred registered Highland youngstock; foals 1,2 and 3yrs old may enter
- Two Championships will be held; one in Scotland (CSHPC Show at Strathallan Castle on 1st September 2024) and one in England (Great British In Hand Show at Oakridge Arena, Newark on 7th September 2024). The qualifying exhibitor can select which Champion Show they wish to enter.
- Exhibitors are not required to be members of the Highland Pony Society for qualifying classes. However, all those competing in the Championships must be members of the Society.
- Entry to the Championships is free.
